Getting the best results with your new Bag Armour!

Silage and Grain Bags

Crown Coverage

Step 1) Cover your filled silage and grain bags with sheets of Bag Armour, making sure the **ROUGH SIDE IS FACING UP!**

Step 2) Overlap each Bag Armour section by 1-2'.

Step 3) Hang weight in the form of Secure Gravel Bags every 10' and include all seams.
-Double Side Handle Secure Gravel Bags are recommended for this application. Use either a rope or a grommet and snap link assembly.

Step 4) Roll back the Bag Armour sheets as you feed out of the bag. Be sure to keep plastic trimmed back to the face. If you have problems with birds feeding from the open portion, drape the face with Bag Armour. When you are finished with a sheet, fold and store clean flat sheets and Secure Gravel Bags out of the sun.



Ground to Ground Coverage

Step 1) Cover your filled silage and grain bags with sheets of Bag Armour, making sure the **ROUGH SIDE IS FACING UP!**

Step 2) Overlap each Bag Armour section by 1-2'.

Step 3) Pull the sheets tight and place Secure Gravel Bags end to end on top of Bag Armour around the entire perimeter of the bag to secure (see bottom photo).

Step 4) Roll back the Bag Armour sheets as you feed out of the bag. Be sure to keep plastic trimmed back to the face. If you have problems with animals and birds feeding from the face, drape the face with Bag Armour. When you are finished with a sheet, fold and store clean flat sheets and Secure Gravel Bags out of the sun.



Recommendation: Using a "rope and two gravel bags assembly" on the feeding edge will help prevent air from blowing up into the bag.
